We are committed to preserving the privacy of your personal health information. In fact we are required by law to protect the privacy of your medical information and to provide you with Notice describing:

HOW MEDICAL INFORMATION ABOUT YOU MAY BE USED AND DISCLOSED AND HOW YOU CAN ACCESS THIS INFORMATION.

Our self-service speech application, PharmaPhonetics™ uses health information about you to develop programs that help patients remember to take their medication, remember their appointments and tests, and help with general compliance issues while using certain medications.

We may be required or permitted by certain laws to use and disclose your medical information for purposes without your consent or authorization. As a user of our services you have important rights relating to inspecting and copying your medical information that we maintain, amending or correcting that information, obtaining an accounting of our disclosures of your medical information, requesting that we communicate with you confidentially, requesting that we restrict uses and disclosures of your health information and complaining if you think your rights have been violated.
